LAGO VISTA ISD EDUCATION FOUNDATION Guidelines for Grant Applications

Purpose:

This program is designed to encourage, facilitate, recognize and reward innovative and creative instructional approaches to the accomplishment of district and/or campus educational initiatives.

Persons Eligible to Apply for Grants:

Individuals or teams of individuals employed by the Lago Vista ISD who are involved in the instruction of students.

Eligible Proposals:

Instructional approaches or projects designed to begin during the 2019-2020 school year.

Award of Funds:

Grants of up to \$15,000 will be awarded to teacher initiated programs or projects. The number of awards will depend on funds available from the Lago Vista ISD Education Foundation.

Due Date:

Applications will be due no later than the 3rd grade reporting periods, unless otherwise specified.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. The degree to which the proposal addresses important grade/course/district educational objectives/TEKS.
- 2. The degree to which the proposal represents a creative or student centered or essential need objective. (It should address a new project or enrich/expands one accomplished or underway.)
- 3. The degree to which the proposal is clear and logical, including (a) specificity of objectives; (b) clarity of description of instructional procedures, methods or treatments; (c) and applicable evaluation.

Selection Process:

- 1. Application forms may be obtained from the principal and/or on the LVISD website.
- 2. Teacher initiated applications must be reviewed by the principal for congruence with specified grade/course curriculum and/or District Goals and signed by the principal.
- 3. Signed applications are due to the Office of Curriculum & Instruction no later than the conclusion of the 3rd grade reporting periods, unless otherwise specified. Once approved, applications will be forwarded to the Education Foundation Grant Application Review committee.
- 4. The Grant Application Review committee made up of the Education Foundation Board of Directors will review applications.
- 5. For each grant application submitted, the committee shall make one of the following recommendations: (a) disapproval; (b) approval with conditions and/or modifications; and (c) approval.
- 6. The Foundation Board of Directors will advise applicant of recommendation.
- 7. Applicants will be notified of decisions one month after the due date for submission.

Responsibilities of Grants Recipients:

- 1. Use the awards for the purposes intended.
- 2. Prepare & present a brief presentation of your project to the Education Foundation Board at their regular February meeting.
- 3. Agree to share successful procedures in staff development sessions.
- 4. Agree that non-consumable purchases will be the property of the District.
- 5. Agree to recognize Lago Vista ISD Education Foundation if published.

Guidelines for Completing the Application:

- 1. The project is appropriate if you can answer yes to the following questions:
- 2. Is it important to learning?
- 3. Does the project support District curriculum in the grade level/course/TEKS and/or addresses a specific goal?
- 4. Are the objectives attainable?
- 5. Is the project innovative/original/creative/challenging /student centered or addresses an essential need?
- 6. Is it a new project or will it enrich/expand one already accomplished or underway?

Tips for Writing a Strong Grant Application

Application should be typed.

Description/Purpose:

- Be sure to respond to the whom? what? when? where? why?
- Explain what achievements are expected, the population and number of student served (e.g. create a picture of the value of the project/expected outcomes; what is difficult and will be better if the project is successful).
- Specify attributes of the proposed project.
- Summarize pertinent information about the project.

Statement of Rationale and/or Need:

- State the need as it relates to your stated purpose.
- State how the project relates to and supports the District Goal(s) & important objectives/TEKS.

Objectives:

- Be specific.
- Limit the number of objectives
- State objectives in measurable terms

Activities:

- Be creative.
- Relate activities to the purpose and objectives.
- Provide a timeline.

Evaluation:

- Indicate the process that will be used to determine the success of the project.
- Describe how the results will be communicated.
- Relate evaluation methods to stated objectives.
